What: Participate in a parade in your community on Memorial Day, 4th of July, or any other parade in your community.

Who: K-12-grade Girl Scouts and their leaders, 1:6 ratio. Parents may help supervise.

When/Where: Each community schedules its own parades. Good sources of information are VFW and American Legion Posts, city clerk and festival chairpersons.

Bring:

- ☞ Permission Slip - Parents of girls participating in parades must complete a permission slip (one is at the bottom of this page) and return it to the Girl Scout leader.

- ☞ Health history form

- ☞ Flags and banners may be borrowed from the Girl Scout Service Center. Please reserve well in advance by calling 835-5331 or 1-800-432-9823.

- ☞ Girls should wear their Girl Scout sash or vest. Uniforms are appropriate, as are nice casual clothes. Wear comfortable walking shoes.
